Nazareth Lutheran Church Council November 20, 2022

Meeting was called to order by President Mark Lewis at 11:47 following worship. Present for the meeting were Mark Lewis, John Egeland, Vince Tomlinson, Lisa Smith, Pastor Marcia, and church administrator Eileen Lewis. Minutes from the September 18 Council Meeting were approved with a correction that the\$674.39 in donations/gifts for the new printer and deck, should be computer not printer.

Treasurer's Report: General Fund's balance began with a total of \$12,354.5810,512.06. \$5,854.31 was added. Disbursements came to \$8,128.48, with \$3,410.17 going towards repairs and upgrades at the parsonage, and the water heater for the church. Savings has a balance of \$421.96, Capital

Improvement stands at \$21,994.35, Mission is \$9,790.52. A motion was made by Eileen to move \$15,000.00 from Capital Improvement to Mission Investment Fund due to the much higher interest rate of 3.5 % that we earn there versus the rate at the bank in the savings account. The money is very liquid in the fund and can be withdrawn at any time without a penalty. John seconded the motion and all approved the move. Lisa will contact Mission Investment fund to move those funds.

Pastor's Report: Children's Sunday school is going very well, there is an average of children there most every week. The children are learning the parables, playing games and doing crafts. In December we will start rehearsing for the play Wombat Divine. Avery is going to be our Angel and Audry is the Wombat. We will have kangaroos, koala bears and even a Tasmanian devil!

Marcia has been wearing her orthotic brace and it is really helping. She has also been feeling better overall. Pastor has also asked for special prayers for members of the congregation who are struggling with illnesses of their family members.

Committee Reports:

Property: It was decided that we should purchase the paint for the parsonage this year, so that we can spread out some of the expenses. Eileen and Marcia have decided on the colors and Eileen will purchase the paint before christmas.

Stewardship: Nothing to report

Inreach / Outreach: Kringla and Lefsa sale was a hit again this year. At this point the total sales is over \$600.00. Lisa reminded the bakers to get an estimate of their costs for reimbursement or to record the donations.

Music and Worship: Hymns selected through January. Ellen was unable to play the organ this week due to a fall. Eileen mentioned that we did receive an advertisement in the mail for a company that would provide the accompaniment to the hymns if we needed an organist. A very brief look through indicated that the cost for the service would be \$65.00 each time they provided the music. It was discussed but determined that we would not ever utilize the service.

Old Business: Event Committee - we have 30 individuals that have agreed to be on the committee. We will divide the group into 3 smaller groups. Then should there be a need for the church to provide some items for a celebration or a funeral the smaller groups will take turns providing the items. We thank everyone who has agreed to be on the committee.

New Business: Wendy Ringgenberg who has been handling our Scrip account for the past many years has indicated that she may need to pass this job to another individual. If you are interested in taking on this position but would like more information, please get in touch with Wendy R and she can explain the process.

We need some additional volunteers to help with the services at church. Please contact Eileen or pastor Marcia if you would like to volunteer to read, usher or help with communion.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:27 by President Mark Lewis and closed with The Lord's Prayer.

Our Nazareth Bakers

Our Bakers worked really hard making the Kringla and Lefsa this year! They made almost 50 dozen orders of Kringla and 30 dozen orders of Lefsa. That is a lot of work! So instead of taking it a little easy they decided to add Kremekaka to their baking. Since this was a new endeavor they only made 100 of them. What?!? only a hundred!! I am tired just thinking about it!

What is Kremekaka you ask? Krumkake, which means "curved cake," is a Norwegian waffle cookie that's shaped like a cone. The cookies are traditionally made using a decorative griddle with flour, sugar, eggs, butter, and milk or cream.

Norwegian immigrants popularized krumkake in New England and the American Midwest. They're often served during the holiday season. When the cookies are served they are filled with whip cream, or a pudding like cream.

Mid Iowa Community Action

Each year we donate some of the money that we collect to Mid Iowa Community Action Inc. (MICA). This agency provides services to people in our community who could not make it on their own. MICA touches the lives of more than 5,000 people each month with assistance with food, energy and crisis assistance, early childhood education, health services, and much more.

The majority of the families that they serve are working full-time, but not making a living wage. They provide immediate assistance, then assist them to get other programs in place to provide ongoing support.

During MICA's existence they have changed the lives of 18,062 people in 6,802 families, (that's enough to fill Wells Fargo and Hilton coliseum with over 1,000 people still waiting for a seat! Of the number served, 2,983 were under the age of 5.

Every single one of these families has a story of how MICA changed their lives. They have helped with reconnecting hundreds of households with heat and water when they are in need, serving mothers and their children with nutritious food and health education through WIC, and giving hundreds of young children a head start through Early Childhood programs.
